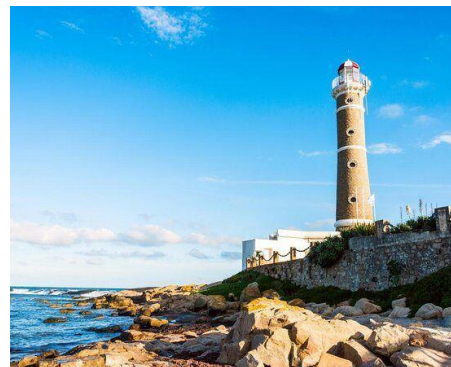
### JOSÉ IGNACIO | Friday 24 November 2023

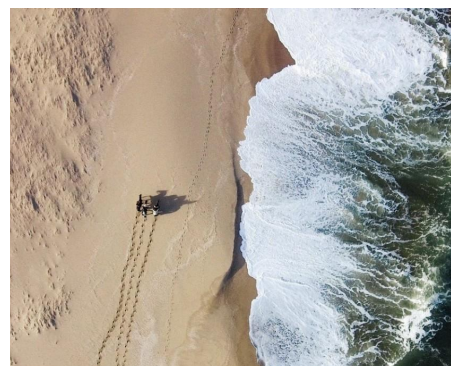
### JOSÉ IGNACIO | Saturday 25 November 2023

Upon reaching the "El Caracol" protected area, we will enter the forest, passing through acacia groves, cacti, and native local plants, before arriving at our destination, where campfires under the stars await. Enjoy an unforgettable dinner in the middle of the forest, with the sound of waves reminding us that the sea is just a few meters away. Return to the hotel.

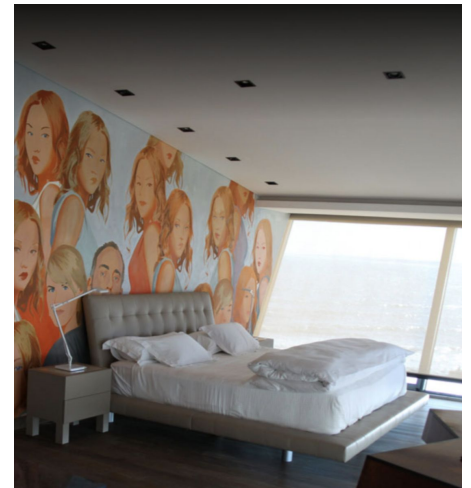

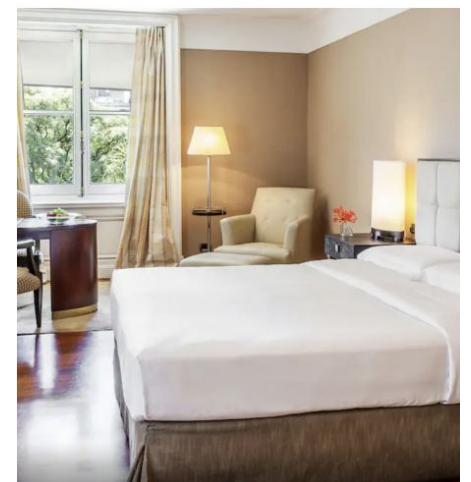

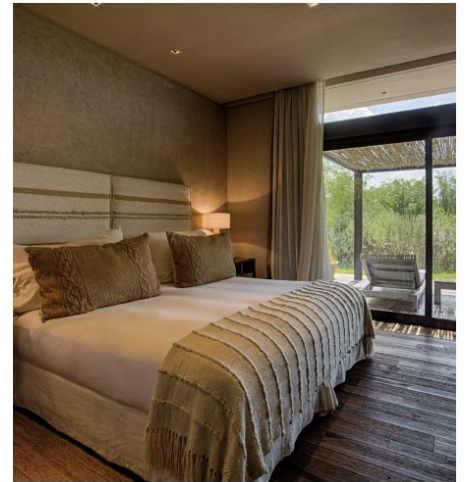
